

- Empowers 18–30-year-olds across Wales to lead with purpose, grounded in the Well-being of Future Generations (Wales) Act
- 70+ hours of bilingual learning delivered online and in-person
- Workshops, residentials, projects, and peer learning

PROGRAMME IMPACT

The 2024–2025 Academy delivered measurable impact across key areas of knowledge, confidence, and leadership practice:



Participants reported an average score of 4.72 our of 5 in their knowledge, confidence, and ability to apply the Well-being of Future Generations Act post-programme (43% increase)



Participant score for understanding of applying the 7 Wellbeing Goals rose from 2.34 out of 5 pre-programme to 4.53 (44% increase)



Confidence in applying the Five Ways of Working rose from 2.38 out of 5 to 4.58 (**44% increase**)



Sessions saw an average score of **4.65 out of 5** for session inclusivity and **4.28 out of 5** for learning effectiveness
